Responsibilities of the University Centre in Svalbard

UNIS will maintain housing of the instruments; provide electric power, heat and Internet UNIS will pay all community and state taxes related to the observatory. UNIS will provide the client with access and use of the observatory's service section, including tool shops, toilet, kitchen, and living room. UNIS will provide help with accommodation in Longyearbyen. All operations regarding safety will be the responsibility of UNIS.

Responsibilities of the client

The client is responsible for transport of the instrument(s) to and from the country of origin, and for the installation of the instrument(s) on site. Any necessary permission for operations (e.g. radio transmission licenses etc.) are the responsibility of the Client. UNIS will not accept responsibility for damage to the environment, or any infringement of rules and laws in force in Norway and/or Svalbard. Military use of data from the observatory is strictly forbidden according to the Svalbard Treaty. Removal of the instrument at the termination of this contract is the responsibility and economic responsibility of the client.

Data access policy

Open co-operation is essential at the observatory in order to make educational and scientific progress. Processed data and instrumental snapshots (if any) should be freely available to the public on the <u>https://kho.unis.no</u> website. Deep level raw data is restricted and available on requests to the Principal Investigators (PIs) of the instruments. Peer review publications should be in Open Access (OA) journals with reference and acknowledgement of the observatory.

Insurance

The KHO building itself is self-insured by the owner the Norwegian Construction and Property Management Department division North (Statsbygg Nord) and does not cover any instrumental client insurance due to fire, extreme weather or any other unforeseen natural damages that could occur to the infrastructure.

Validity

This contract is valid 1 year from start date 1 January commencing end of period 31 December in 2025.

Costs

The Client will pay UNIS an annual accommodation fee of **NOK 25 000** per instrumental unit. The fee will be adjusted on a yearly base according to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) from Statistics Norway and any adjustments imposed by the owner Statsbygg - the Norwegian government building commissioner at Svalbard.

The full annual amount is payable in a lump sum each year upon receipt of an invoice which will be issued during the observation season. The invoice must be paid to:
